4) Global Health Financing

Global health financing addresses the resources available for global health, including domestic and external financing of national health systems and the joint financing of global public goods. Efficient and fair allocation of these resources are critical questions, and Universal Health Coverage (UHC) as well as epidemic preparedness are among the top issues on the agenda. We invite applicants to explore the financing of UHC and epidemic preparedness, including the question of whether current policies to make progress on these areas are synergistic or in tension.
