News from Norwegian Research School in Global Health: Two courses in research methods. They have handed out several research grants to PhD candidates. They are also working on the program for the PHD conference in April 2018, in connection with the Forum conference

32/17 Working group for changing the Statutes for Forum (Attachment 2) We apologize for sending the form with all track changes, we hope you all manage to read the main points.

The working group, consisting of Bente Moen, Frode Forland, Stine Braathen, Elin Dvergsdal, Nils Gunnar Songstad, Eirik Vikum and Gunhild Koldal made these suggested changes in the statues in a meeting at Gardermoen on 20 June. The main changes are suggested in connection with the newly established GHN. There the representatives are appointed by their institutions. The working group suggest that the new Forums board members are elected as individuals, not by representing an institution. The board is elected on the general assembly that is held once a year. The next general assembly is in Oslo in April 2018, so we have to decide a model to present there. The working group will prepare this and present a model for the existing board to decide upon. All board members are encouraged to look into different models. Many questions need to be answered within April 2018. The role of Norwegian Forum for Global Health Research needs to be considered together with the role of GHN, and presented for both parties.

33/17 How can Forum work on the issue of increase funding in Global Health?

Input from RCN, Health Directorate, Norad is warmly welcomed. As there were no representatives from RCN we asked Ingvar Olsen and Jan Sigurd Røtnes for advice. The main source for funding in the field of Global Health has been GLOBVAC, a program most members of the board are familiar with. GLOBVAC has received reduced funds, and we might have to look to NORGLOBAL, FRIMEDBIO and other programs in the future. The long term perspective needs to be considered, as GLOBVAC is only planned til 2020. NORHED is a program administered by Norad, and there might be new calls from them. EDCTP is the program within EU with focus on clinical trials in sub-Saharan Africa.

The Forum was advised to contact the reference group on health at RCN, they are lobbing for Norwegian interests in EU, and we can try to make an impact here:
