# 81/20 Comments to our Membership meeting

There was a board meeting in GHN 26/11-20, where the budget for 2021 was decided. NOK 75 000 for Forum was included in the budget. We are pleased. Decision: 50 000 NOK will be used for the secretariat (at present for frikjøp of G. Koldal at CIH, UiB). The rest will be used for Forum activities otherwise. Bente presents a budget in the next Forum meeting.

The issue of the secretariat must be discussed in the board before the GA, and we must also probably change the text in the Statutes, Article VIII Secretariat.
