

Minutes General Assembly 2008

31 October 2008, 1300-1430 Radisson SAS Royal Hotel, Bergen

General Assembly participants: 32 members and 3 observers of Norwegian Forum for Global Health Research

Welcome and opening

The General Assembly was opened by the chair of the board, Gunnar Kvåle, who suggested Gro Th. Lie to be elected as chair of the General Assembly. The General Assembly approved the suggested chair.

Approval of the agenda

The agenda was approved.

Activities of Norwegian Forum for Global Health Research

a) Report on activities 2007-2008

Gunnar Kvåle briefed the General Assembly on the activities in 2007 and 2008. Members of the General Assembly suggested that representation in international organizations, e.g. the Global Forum for Health Research, should be on the agenda of Norwegian Forum for Global Health Research. The General Assembly members also suggested that the board should continue the work on establishing a national research school in global health and that the effort of putting global health research on the agenda following the report NOU 2008:14 Samstemt for utvikling? Hvordan en helhetlig norsk politikk kan bidra til utvikling i fattige land should continue. The workshop on implementation research in June 2008 where the Norwegian Forum for Global Health Research was a co-organizer was also pointed out as an important activity.

b) Work plan 2009

Gunnar Kvåle briefed the General Assembly on the work plan for 2009. Some issues were suggested to be included in the work plan:

- The high rate of researchers reaching retirement age and the limited recruitment to global health research should be addressed
- The pool of knowledge available through the Norwegian Open Research Archives (NORA) should be made available through the Norwegian Forum for Global Health Research
- c) Inventory of global health research projects in Norway

Nils Gunnar Songstad briefed the General Assembly on the inventory of global health research and the information available.



Approval of election procedures and election of the new board 2009 – 2010

Nils Gunnar Songstad presented the suggested procedures for election of new board members. The procedures were approved but members of the General Assembly raised some issues concerning the elections. Jon Øyvind Odland proposed that the chairperson of the board preferably should be elected directly by the General Assembly. It was suggested that it is considered if the Statutes should be revised on this point.
