17/21 Projects in partnership with LMIC

LMIC projects at the universities are not awarded as other research projects, since we often transfer funding to LMIC. This kind of activity is not awarded by Faculty/University/Ministry. A working group is needed to look further into this area.

There are different ways the universities award research environments that secure funding for projects, dependent on the funder, such as RCN; EU, Norad.

Forum board creates a working group to start looking into the universities' routines, for instance how PhD scholarships are rewarded, and work towards creating an incentive programme for Norhed-projects awarded.
